The B.A. in Humanities, Interdisciplinary Studies consists of The Marauder Foundation General Education Program and the following major courses:

- Part I The Major Core: IDS 2100, ENG 2200, PHI 2240, BUS 1500, HIS 2202, and IDS 4500 (18 credits)
- Part II The Humanities Concentration: 3 courses in one discipline from ENG, HIS, PHI, or COM at the 3000 level or above (9 credits)
- Part III Theoretical Course: course discipline must match Part II concentration from ENG 3100, HIS 2100, PHI 3500, or COM 3306 (3 credits)
- Part IV: Humanities Electives: 3 courses in ANY discipline from COM, ENG, HIS, PHI, FLA 2000-level or above. 1
 outside the Part II HUM Concentration (9 credits)
- Part V: Other Required Courses: 2 courses in the same international language and 2 additional humanities courses
 from the following disciplines, art, drama, history, linguistics, literature, music, philosophy, religion, speech, and
 international languages (beyond the first year of the course (14 credits)

Courses not included in the Marauder Foundation or the major will be transferred as University Electives.

Transfer courses will be applied the B.A. in Humanities, Interdisciplinary Studies to the following sections. Students should consult with their advisor on the application of the credits upon matriculation.
